PENDULOUS SEDGE

Carex pendula

In Wildlife Garden near pond; first photo shows it flowering early May; the second photo shows it fruiting in June. The male flower is the top one only, the others are female.





PERENNIAL RYE-GRASS Lolium perenne

Flowering in June.





BRANCHED BUR-REEDSparganium erectum
